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✓ **Publication :**

- All manuscripts will be evaluated basing on content without regard to ethnic origin, gender, sexual orientation, citizenship, religious belief or political philosophy of the authors
- All submitted papers are subject to peer-review process by at least one reviewer and that are experts in the area of the particular paper.
- The factors that are taken into account in review are significance, originality, readability and language.
- The possible decisions include acceptance, acceptance with major/minor revisions, or rejection.
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- The paper acceptance is constrained by such legal requirements as shall then be in force regarding copyright infringement and plagiarism.

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- Authors must certify that the manuscript has not previously been published elsewhere.
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- All Authors mentioned in the paper must be informed about the submission of paper.
- Authors must state that all data in the paper are real and authentic.
- Authors must notify the Editor-in-chief of any conflicts of interest.
- Authors must identify all sources used in the creation of their manuscript.
- Authors must report any errors they discover in their published paper to the Editor-in-chief.

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- Authors should read and agree the Publication Ethics and Malpractice Statement and guidelines for authors before the submission of paper
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
