The Mixed Picture Puzzle

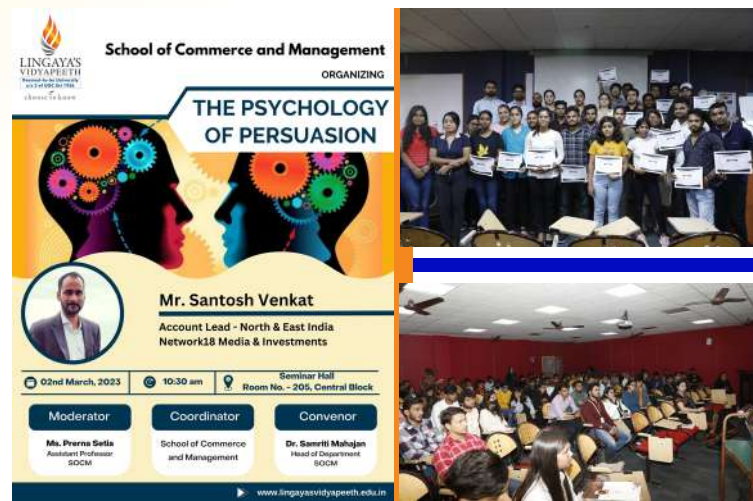
International Faculty and Student Development Programme
